## REGARDING PARTICIPATION

- ◆ Invited schools are requested to confirm their participation by sending a mail to [thsmun@theheritageschool.net.in](mailto:thsmun@theheritageschool.net.in) by the 1st of June, 2024. A registration form will be sent after your confirmation which is required to be filled and sent back by the 15th of June, 2024.
- ◆ The demand draft/cash has to be submitted to The Heritage School Admin between 11 am and 2 pm on any working day OR between 8:30 am and 9:30 am on the first day of the conference.
- ◆ Participating schools are requested to send a delegation comprising a minimum of 6 students.
- ◆ Lunch and refreshments will be served to all delegates and faculty advisor(s) during the conference.
- ◆ Transport to and from the school premises are to be arranged by the participating schools.
- ◆ As the students will be attending regular school, we would urge the participants to contact the Secretariat during weekdays after 5pm and any time during weekends for any queries.
- ◆ All participants are expected to follow the school's code of conduct. If any student is found misbehaving or involved in any act of indiscipline, the head delegate or teacher faculty present on campus will be informed regarding the act and will be expected to take responsibility.
- ◆ Withdrawal by registered participants will result in repercussions ranging from point deduction to non-consideration for delegation awards for the participating school unless a replacement is made at least 24 hours prior to the conference.

## REGARDING PAYMENT

- ◆ The registration fee per delegate is ₹1800/-. The payment of the delegation fee can be either made by demand draft or cash (no cheque). The demand draft must be payable to "The Heritage School".
- ◆ The draft/cash has to be submitted to The Heritage School administration office between 8:30 am and 9:30 am on the first day of the conference.
- ◆ Please note that once the delegation fee is paid it is non-refundable.
